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## **Description**

This seminar introduces students to key concepts, foundational theories, and approaches to the study of global health from a multidisciplinary perspective, combining the insights of political science/international relations and public health/medicine. Using the analytical leverage of political science and medicine, the seminar covers the following major topics: (1) global health challenges for governance, (2) sustainable development, and (3) transnational governance and policies of global health. The seminar involves several sessions with analysis and discussion of specific topics of global health governance on the basis of a selected academic texts. The participation in this course includes as well the attendance of two events that help build the understanding of political processes in global health, and the public discussion on global health and sustainable development:

- Symposium on Sustainable Development in Africa, November 16, 2018
- Global Health Day, December 7, 2018

## **Evaluation:**

The module grade is based on a written examination in the form of a seminar paper (13 – 15 pages). Through their seminar paper, students will document to which extent they have gained a foundational understanding in the area of global governance, ethics and technology and whether they are able to apply the introduced theories and approaches to analyze specific policy problems. Furthermore, it will be reviewed whether the students understand how the introduced theories challenge and differ from conventional theories. The seminar paper is accompanied by a presentation (15 - 30 min) to test the communicative competence of presenting scientific topics to an audience. The presentation must be supplemented by a short-written handout. The module grade consists of the seminar paper (80%) and the presentation (20%). **Deadline for submission of seminar papers: March 20, 2019.
