Specific Pathology(spezielle Pathologie):

Classes:

The classes of specific pathology take place in the lessons of <u>IDV 2.1 and 2.2</u> (<u>Interdisziplinäre Vorlesung 2.1 and 2.2</u>). They are based on the knowledge you have from the course of general Pathology that we do in the first clinical year.

The lessons take place from Monday till Friday from 8.15 a.m. to 9.45 a.m for one academic year (two terms, summer and winter term)

Lessons start in the 4th week of the term. (In the first 3 weeks there are only practical training courses)

Lecture 2.1 only takes place in summerterm, lecture 2.2 only takes place in winterterm, but it is possible to attend both exams in every term. students).

There is no control of attendance during the lessons

The lessons of IDV 2.1 and 2.2 are also containing surgery and internal medicine, so does the exam. So you have to to pass the complete exam successfully to get the credits.
